Directions: Take I-271 North to I-90 East to the Route 215 exit, approximately 5 miles into Pennsylvania. Follow Route 215 across Route 20, a set of railroad tracks, across Route 5, then another set of railroad tracks until you get to a fork in the road. At the fork, look for Peggy Gray Candy Store, and take the right fork and watch for Camp Fitch signs on the right. Camp Fitch is 4.9 miles from I-90. Phone number is 814-922-3219.
